Discussion 1: Church services (New Name classes) don't make you feel loved. Healthy relationships through personal investments over time convince us of our value and sense of being loved. Acceptance says, "I will take you as you are." Accountability says, "I will take you further; I value you too much to look the other way, because to do so would be to treat you with contempt."

Drill Down 1:

- Share a time when you have held a brother accountable and how it helped them go further in their relationship with God and others.

- Now share a time when you chose to hold a brother in contempt and how it impacted their relationship with God and others.

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Discussion 2: We were created on purpose and God has a purpose for our lives.

Drill Down 2:

- Share your sense of God’s purpose for your life and what will this look like?

- Share where you’re presently at in living God’s purpose for your life and what you think would help take you to the next level in achieving God’s purpose for your life.

Discussion 3: The Word tells us to “Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.” James 5:16

Drill Down 3:

- What faults have you not confessed with other believers?

- How’s that working for you?
