Introduction: How well do we understand honor? When do we choose to give honor? Why do we wait? Honor is where you recognize who a person is without stumbling over who they are not.

Discussion 1: We often confuse flattery with honor. Flattery is about improving our self-image or increasing favor by bribing others with nice comments. Honor speaks the truth in love on the basis of the greatness God has already implanted in a person

Drill Down 1:

1. What is the difference between flattering someone and honoring them?
2. Describe a time when you flattered someone instead of honoring them.
 - a. Were you edifying them by doing this or were you serving yourself?
 - b. If you truly wanted to honor this other person, what truth could you have spoken to them in love?
