**Instructions:** Insecurities come from convincing ourselves that how we feel is who we are. Reconciling ourselves to our true identity in Christ brings a level of confidence that will overcome anything life (or the enemy) throws at us.

### Drill Down 1:

- Share about a time in your life when you compared your “behind the scenes” with someone else’s “highlight reel”.
- When you did this, how much did you know about the other person’s struggles before their victories?
- When you did this, how much did you dismiss your own victories?
- Share one of your dismissed victories from this period in your life?

**Discussion 2:** When you doubt the product, you doubt the maker. “I can do all this through him who gives me strength.” (Philippians 4:13)

### Drill Down 2:

- If you really believed the verse above, what would your life look like?
- When considering your current level of confidence (or lack of it), how has your life looked?
- Is there a difference between your two answers above that you would like to repent of (change the way you think)?

**Post Class Instructions:** When you notice a brother struggling, and threatened with insecurity, remind him of his identity in Christ and the magnificence of his maker.
