Drill Down 1:

Drill Down 2:

- If you really believed the verse above, what would your life look like?
- When considering your current level of confidence (or lack of it), how has your life looked?
- Is there a difference between your two answers above that you would like to repent of (change the way you think)?

Post Class Instructions: When you notice a brother struggling, and threatened with insecurity, remind him of his identity in Christ and the magnificence of his maker.
