Instructions: Read Genesis 3:1-6. Notice in verse 3 how the serpent plants the seed of an orphan spirit into Eve's heart: "God does not have your best interest at heart" and "in your current condition, you lack value." The orphan spirit/heart questions God's goodness and our value. With an orphan spirit, we are blinded to our Heavenly Father's extravagant love for us as well as believing that we lack where we already have abundance.

Discussion 1: If Jesus died on the cross because you are valuable, how can you honor Him if you don't understand your value or self-worth?

Drill Down 1:

- Share how your lack of self-worth has effected your ability or willingness to honor what Jesus did on the cross.

- When you do not value yourself the way Jesus values you, how does that reflect your belief about the integrity of Christ?

- If your value as a person was based on what you do, what would your life look like?

- If your value as a person was based on your identity in Christ, what would your life look like?

Discussion 2: When you start to question your own goodness or value, you start to wonder about God's goodness; so, you begin to seek things for your life that will make you feel better about yourself.

Drill Down 2:

- What would your life look like if you believed the above?

- If you fully believe in your value and God's goodness, what would your life look like?

Drill Down 3:

- If you were living **for** God, what would your life look like?

- If you were living **from** God, what would your life look like?

- Based on this lesson, is there anything you need to repent of? If so, please describe.
