Do not believe the lies and rumors circulating in that prison, the ones that label you as a felon or carry a stigma for certain crimes. I am living proof that positive things can and will happen in your life in God's time. You will meet amazing people who will assist you if you are willing to help yourself, providing food, clothing, and even free dental care. I was released on October 12, 2022, with a fractured arm and a stimulus check. Due to arm surgery, I couldn't work for four months, but when the doctor cleared me for work, the Lord blessed me with a job at a linen and uniform service unloading heavy bags from eighteen-wheelers and placing them on a conveyor belt or hooks. I worked there for a little over ninety days, riding my bike 2.1 miles there and back. One day, while it was pouring rain, I questioned God, wondering what I had done to deserve this. Then I felt humbled as the Holy Spirit reminded me that God sent His one and only Son to die for me, undeserving as I am. I continued to work diligently, as if working for the Lord, from Monday to Friday, and saved enough money to eventually afford a vehicle. God then blessed me with a better-paying job at DHL LEGO as an order picker, handling lighter boxes with less stress. I want you all to know what the Lord has done for me, He can and will do for you. All you need to do is believe and remain faithful to our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, for He shows no partiality. I am no different from you or anyone else. I hope these words provide you with encouragement. With much love and respect, your brother in Christ.
